### **I want to know more about Shri Vishwakarma Skill University.**

Shri Vishwakarma Skill University (SVSU), university's current name, is amended from its earlier name of The Haryana Vishwakarma Skill University. The name change came in effect on October 02, 2018 and was published in Haryana Government Gazette (Extra) of October 22, 2018 (ASVN. 30. 1940 SAKA) by way of an Act known as The Haryana Vishwakarma Skill University (Amendment) Act, 2018.

Mission of the university is to focus on quality of skill education, aspired by students and admired by industry, nationally and internationally, and the university wants to emerge as one of the foremost institutions of quality in skill education acknowledged by industry, nationally and internationally.”

### **What is B.Voc?**

B. Voc means Bachelor of Vocation. This is like any other degree program but with an added emphasis on the skills related to your chosen field of study. After completion of a regular degree, you earn a certificate; but after completion of B.Voc, you come out as a skilled person.

### **What is Industry Integrated Dual Education Model?**

The university has developed Operating Model Framework for deploying Industry Integrated Dual Education Model for various NSQF level under "Earn While Learn" programme for the aspiring youth. The entire model (IIDEM) has been converted into a Standard Process Manual as well. The model envisages enrollment of students under integrated plan of NAPS and vocational classroom education.

**What are the objectives of these programmes i.e. Dual Education System?**

The objective of Dual Education System programme is:

- I. To provide judicious mix of skills relating to a profession and appropriate content of General Education.
- II. To ensure that the students have adequate knowledge and skills, so that they are work ready at each exit point of the programme.
- III. To provide flexibility to the students by means of pre-defined entry and multiple exit points.
- IV. To integrate NSQF within the undergraduate level of higher education in order to enhance employability of the graduates and meet industry requirements. Such graduates apart from meeting the needs of local and national industry are also expected to be equipped to become part of the global workforce.
- V. To provide vertical mobility to students coming out of 10+2 with vocational subjects also.

**What is NSQF and its various levels?**

NSQF stands for National Standard Qualification Framework. It has 10 levels from 1 to 10. Each level corresponds with a specific job role.

### **What is OJT and campus-industry model?**

OJT means on-the-job-training. Such training is imparted at the partner industry sites. This enables students to gain as much practical training in their field of study as theoretical. The campus-industry model draws its inspiration from the German Dual Education model. The system produces highly skilled, ready-to-work employees for the industry. In this model industry's participation in training is far greater than traditional academic and vocational skilling initiatives and programmes. Students work and study at the industrial premises and industry-simulated university campuses for the entire duration of training.
