About the Program:

World Youth Skills Day is an annual observance celebrated on July 15th. It aims to raise awareness about the importance of skill development among young people and promote the acquisition of technical and vocational skills for employment, entrepreneurship, and personal development.

The United Nations General Assembly declared World Youth Skills Day in 2014 as part of its resolution on youth employment. This day serves as a platform to highlight the challenges faced by young individuals in accessing skill training and employment opportunities, as well as the significant role that skills development plays in addressing youth unemployment and fostering sustainable development.

The overarching goal of World Youth Skills Day is to empower young individuals with the necessary skills to participate effectively in the workforce, contribute to economic growth, and lead fulfilling lives. It recognizes the potential of young people as agents of change and emphasizes the importance of investing in their skill development to build a sustainable and inclusive future.

SVSU advocates empowering the students with Skill knowledge and strongly believe in a holistic development of its students.

About the University:

The Government of India has put a renewed focus around skilling and entrepreneurship development with an objective to enable social and economic progress. In line with this vision, the Government of Haryana has launched India's first Skill development University Shri Vishwakarma Skill University - (SVSU)Palwal, Haryana, through an act of legislation.

SVSU has adopted Industry Integrated Dual Education Model (IIDEM) for its NSQF aligned Diploma, UG, PG & Ph.D. programmes in Vocational Studies in line with German Dual Model vocation education pedagogy. University conducts these courses with active participation of industries in various business domains. This education model facilitates "Earn-While-Learn" and provides the students with the opportunity to enhance their qualification with flexibility of entry and exit into a programme.

Industry partner proactively participate from end-to-end in programme conceptualization, curriculum design and development, students' selection process and On Job Training (OJT) in the industry premise for real time learning of the students. SVSU pedagogy is hands-on exposure of students to acquire relevant skill sets required by the industry through OJT. Currently SVSU has 40 % classroom and 60% on the job training for its existing programmes. Industry partner, faculty & students jointly find out solutions/insights in business problems by adopting proactive approach through experiential learning.
