1. Background

About Shri Vishwakarma Skill University (SVSU)

Shri Vishwakarma Skill University (SVSU) was established by the Government of Haryana under Act 25 of 2016 to provide structured skill qualification programs aligned with existing and emerging job roles in the high employability and focus Industries in the state like automotive manufacturing, IT/ITES, Logistics, etc. This is in line with the Skill India Mission which was launched by the Government of India to empower the youth of the country with skill sets that make them more employable and more productive in their work environment. The aim of the university through the Dual Skill Model is to create a skilled and motivated job-ready workforce to enhance employability in the state while providing a high-quality workforce with greater retention. To achieve this the University has created multiple customized Certificate, Diploma, Graduation, and Post-Graduation programs to expose students of schools and colleges to provide alternate/complimentary career pathways based on their aspirations and profiles. These programs have experiential learning, which is integrated with the classroom, practical, On the Job Training (OJT), and National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS).

Primary Objectives of SVSU for Scheme:

Shri Vishwakarma Skill University (SVSU) has a mandate from Haryana Skill Development Mission (HSDM) to execute skill training under the IT Saksham Yuva Scheme. For this, SVSU would like to engage the Training Management Support Agency (TMSA), which should have relevant operational experience, to conduct End-to-End Skill Trainings. Program quality and monitoring will be jointly evaluated by SVSU and HSDM as per its quality standards, procedures, and policies.

2. Introduction to Scheme

2.1 “IT Saksham Yuva Scheme 2024” has been proposed by the Haryana Government to employ youths (Graduates/Post-Graduates applicants) from engineering and IT backgrounds who shall undertake the Haryana IT Program (specially designed short-term courses) for the duration of minimum 3 months implemented by Shri Vishwakarma Skill

University (SVSU), Haryana State Electronics Development Corporation Limited (HARTRON), and Haryana Knowledge Corporation Limited (HKCL) or any other agency notified by Government from time to time.

2.2 These skilled and eligible IT Saksham Yuva shall be given employment in various Departments/ Boards/ Corporations/ Districts/ Registered Societies/ Agencies, etc. under the Haryana Government or private entities. The first phase of the scheme shall employ **5,000 youths** in the State by training them through **specially designed IT courses** such as:

- i. Secure coding in Java, DotNet, PHP, etc.
- ii. DBA in SQL, Postgre SQL, etc.
- iii. UI/ UX design, web design
- iv. Networking - Network support, LAN/ WAN
- v. Server Administration Microsoft/ Linux
- vi. Web and mobile application development
- vii. Digital Marketing & social media handling
- viii. Any other course, in the field of Emerging Technologies, can be added as per need.

2.3 This scheme is envisioned to provide the youth of Haryana a much-needed career-readiness for the digital world of work, and imbibement of desired skills necessary to enter effectively into the 21st Century workplaces in various digital domains. The Citizen Resources Information Department (CRID) will facilitate in providing employment opportunities to these trained IT Saksham Yuva and the eligible applicant will be employed for a duration of 2 years. An indicative list of IT programs is placed in Annexure-7.

2.4 Objective of Scheme

The objective of the scheme is to position Haryana as a leading IT powerhouse by leveraging its human capital potential, fostering innovation, creating a conducive ecosystem for technology-driven growth, and strengthening e-governance in the State.

The scheme aims to provide employment to the eligible youths of Haryana by training them under the IT program intended to upgrade their skills. This is further expected to enable the youth to develop their skill which in turn will give them the needed experience, thereby enabling them to take up better employment or self-employment in the IT sector.

3. Eligibility Criteria

The Applicant shall fulfill all the following Eligibility Criteria independently, as date of submission of the Proposal. The eligibility criteria for submitting a proposal and engagement with SVSU for imparting skill training is as under:

5. Scope of Work

The applicants who meet the eligibility criteria and are selected by SVSU following due selection process shall be engaged as Training Management Support Agency (TMSA) for imparting skill training in NSQF-aligned courses. The responsibilities of the Training Management Support Agency will be based upon important aspects of the skill development training eco-system as follows:

5.1 Mobilization, Counselling and Selection

The youth will be mobilised keeping in view demographics. The youth mobilized for training should be from Haryana. Having a PPP ID Preference should be given to youth from rural areas and unemployed youth.

Candidates desirous of being skilled and employed shall be selected for the training. It should be based on pre-counseling to reduce the dropout ratio in initial phase. Ideal batch of 25-30 trainees is recommended for the training and shall not exceed 30 trainees per batch.

5.2 Training Infrastructure and Lab arrangements

The Training Infrastructure and Space will be provided by the training center. The Skill training should be conducted in the Training Centre (TC) which should be established/identified by the selected Training management Support Agency (TMSA) with required Labs and equipment in the State of Haryana. **Trainers**
All Trainers engaged in the project should be ToT certified before the commencement of the training.

5.3 Assessment and Certification

- a. Trainees completing the training shall be required to undergo a standardized assessment by SVSU and shall be awarded certificate in the allotted NSQF job role by the Awarding Body (SVSU).
- b. Batch-wise, the candidates fulfilling the eligibility conditions of job role and completing at least 70% attendance criteria shall be allowed for the assessment and certification.

5.4 Financial Accounts & Auditing

1. The Training cost which would be broadly based on the indicative common norms notified by the Haryana Skill Development Mission (HSDM) Government of Haryana (GoH) or as per the funding pattern provided by any State or organization will be shared with the SVSU.
2. The Training cost of the batch shall be paid in 3 tranches in the ratio 30:40:30, subject to submission of all relevant documents as mentioned in the agreement for each tranche
3. Raising Invoice: The Agency will raise the invoices in 3 tranches within the below-mentioned time frame, as under:

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- For 1st Tranche Invoice: To be raised batch-wise within 25 days from the Batch start date for 30% of the training cost.
- For 2nd Tranche Invoice: To raise batch-wise within 60 days from the date of Batch Certification for the next 40% of the training cost.
- For 3rd Tranche Invoice: To be raised batch-wise within 180 days from the date of Batch Certification and placement/ Employment data submission
- TMSA would provide bank account details for the funds to be transferred by the SVSU.

The Agency shall be responsible for keeping accurate and systematic records in respect of the services in such form and detail that clearly identify all relevant funds received from SVSU to the selected agency and payments made to enable SVSU to inspect the same at any point in time, duly audited by its own/external auditor.

6. General Information

6.1 Tenure of Engagement

The tenure of engagement is based on Project completion (initially for **1 year**) from work order issuance/ signing of legal agreement and may be **renew or Extend based upon the requirement and performance** as per guidelines and standards or any further circular, orders issued by SVSU.

SVSU, at its discretion, can modify or terminate the contract earlier than the expiry of the above-mentioned period in the event of a change in law or due to other relevant reason(s).

6.2 Sub-Contracting

The Training should be conducted in the Training Centre (TC) only, which has been identified by the selected Training Management Support Agency (TMSA) with the required Labs and equipment either at SVSU, Dudhola (Palwal) / Gurugram Campus or in an affiliated centre of SVSU or other Private Training center in the State of Haryana.

The selected Agency shall not sub-contract or enter into a franchising mode with any party at any stage, if SVSU detects a franchising arrangement and Agency found to be unable to show appropriate documents, the targets shall be revoked, and the entire **Performance Guarantee (PG)** may be forfeited along with a penalty.

6.3 Monitoring and Supervision

Monitoring & Supervision will be done at various levels by SVSU & HKCL and/or its nominated agency to ensure quality and outcome-based training. It would be done via technology driven interventions as well as physical inspections.

6.4 Applicant to Inform

The Applicant shall be deemed to have carefully examined and understood the complete Document prior to submission of their Proposal. If the Applicant has any doubts/

clarifications as to the meaning of any portion of the conditions or the specifications of the Document or its subsequent corrigendum they shall, before the last date for submission of Pre-Submission Queries, set forth thereof and submit them to SVSU in writing in order that such doubts are clarified.

In all matters regarding queries raised by the Applicants on the clauses of the Document, interpretation of clauses, scope, terms and conditions, instructions etc. as stated in this Document and/or its subsequent corrigenda/addenda, if any, the decision of SVSU shall be final and binding on all Applicants.

6.5 Meeting regarding Clarifications

SVSU shall hold a consultation meeting with the prospective industrial units and corporate houses as per the date and time defined in the Fact Sheet of this document. The Applicant(s) shall have to ensure that their queries for Pre-Submission meeting are submitted by email on or before the date and time as defined in the Fact Sheet of this Document. The queries need to be sent on the email id defined in the communication section in the Fact Sheet of this Document.

- a. The queries should be submitted in the following format:

6.6 Responses to Pre-Bid Queries and Issue of Corrigendum

- a. The Corrigendum (if any) & clarifications to the relevant queries from Applicants shall be posted on the www.svsu.ac.in. Applicants are advised to check the SVSU website frequently for all updates regarding this document.

- b. Any such corrigendum shall be deemed to be incorporated into this document and shall be considered as its part.
- c. To provide prospective Applicant(s) reasonable time considering the corrigendum, SVSU may, at its discretion, extend the last date for the receipt of proposals.

6.7 Language of Proposal

The Proposal prepared by the Applicant, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the proposal exchanged by the Applicant and SVSU shall be written in English only.

6.8 Verification of Submitted Documents

The required documents/ supporting documents submitted by the Applicant against eligibility criteria may be verified by the SVSU from the issuing Authority. The Applicant should ensure that the required documents/ supporting documents are on the letter head of the issuing authority and clearly exhibits Name, Address, Contact Number, E-Mail Id of the issuing authority.
