About the Programme

Banchari folk art is an old culture of Brij. This rich art form is today confined to few villages in Faridabad and Palwal districts and is being kept alive by few artists, through guru-shishya parampara. The art form is mostly dedicated to Radha-Krishna worship, divine love, and comprises of singing, dancing and playing of various musical instruments. The songs are based on ragas, which include devotional, rasiya (love songs), martial, patriotic, holi songs, singing paeans, and songs to suit every occasion. Banchari artists also stage Ram Leela and other plays. Musical instruments like harmonium, dholak, manjeera, bansuri and jhanj are played by the artists, but the most impressive instruments are its huge nagada (war drum). Banchari troupe looks simple, rustic yet impressive in kurta-pajama with a colourful turban and garland.

Programme Model & Pedagogy

SVSU has built a strong partnership with the Industry to facilitate students' training, employability and entrepreneurship through the On-the-Job Training (OJT) approach. The university has designed, developed and deployed Industry Integrated Dual Education Model (IIDEM) that enables students to "earn-while-learn" and provides an opportunity to enhance their qualification with the flexibility of entry and exit into a programme. SVSU has conceptualised the IIDEM programme, which is designed in such a manner that 60 percent of the credits are earned while working on the OJT and the rest 40 percent come from the theoretical and conceptual training. The entire pedagogy is designed to develop an application-based learning that makes students job-ready by earning industry work experience and learning the technical concepts hands-on.

3. Practice Ragni, Rasiya, Aalaha and Hori in the context of Banchari Music.
4. To practice taal pattern - Keharwa, Dadra, Rupak and Teentaal.
5. To prepare for stage performances.
6. Kafi, Bilawal and Bhairav.ragas practice
7. To compile works of Banchari singers like Sh. Shiv Charan and Pt. Doolichand in the field of Folk music.
8. To write notation of Rasiya or Hori.
9. To participate in Suraj Kund Mela, village Ram Leela, Holi festival and other recognised national, international platforms.
