CORRIGENDUM/ADDENDUM

Online applications are invited from the eligible applicant for appointment for various Teaching posts on regular basis up to 18/12/2020 vide Advertisement No. SVSU/2020/Estt. /T/008.

In the advertisement the qualification for the post of **Skill Assistant Professor (Remote Sensing/ GIS)** to be read as under:

1. **A (i)** “B. E. / B. Tech. / B. S and M. E. / M. Tech. / M. S. or Integrated M. Tech. in relevant branch with first class or equivalent in any one of the Degrees”

OR

A Master’s degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/ allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.

- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M. Phil/Ph. D degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET;

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing ordinances/ Bye- laws/ regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such PhD candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/ SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/ Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions: -

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate had been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voice of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/ her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a referred journal;
- e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars, based on his/her Ph. D work.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note:

NET/ SLET/ SET shall also not be required for such master's programmes in disciplines for which NET/ SLET/ SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by UGC, like SLET/ SET

OR

B. The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following:

- i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS)
- ii) The Times Higher Education (THE) or
- iii) The Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

2. Knowledge of Hindi/ Sanskrit up to Matric.
