If more than one circle for the question is found darkened or if any other circle carries any other mark, the question will be treated as cancelled.
- (iii) Another 04 questions, i.e. Q 61 to 64, are subjective types questions. For answering these questions, an applicant has to use Part 2 of the Answer-Sheet. **Please note that the answers of these questions must be limited to be written on the answer sheet in the provided space only. The applicant MUST NOT write the answers anywhere else.**
- (iv) The candidate should write his/her details at the places provided on the cover page of the Test-Booklet/Question Paper and on the Answer-Sheet and NOWHERE ELSE.
- (v) No second Test-Booklet or Answer-Sheet will be provided. The applicants are advised to be careful in handling it and marking the answer on the Answer-Sheet.
- (vi) For every correct answer of the question (Q1 to 60) One (1) mark will be awarded. For every un-attempted question, Zero (0) mark shall be awarded. There is no Negative Marking.

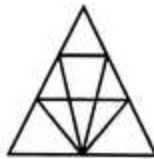

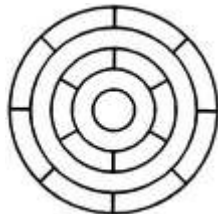
