WALK-IN-INTERVIEW FOR EMPANELMENT OF GUEST FACULTY POSITIONS

Shri Vishwakarma Skill University (SVSU) is first Government Skill University established by the Government of Haryana, which is functioning from its transit campus in Gurugram, Faridabad, premises of its industry partners and permanent campus in Dudhola, Palwal. Eligible candidates are invited for walk-in-interview for empanelment of Guest Faculty positions for the Session 2021-22 in **Chemistry** area/subject of the University.

Candidates are required to bring one set of self-attested documents along with original documents on 13th April 2022 at 8.30 AM at the time of interview. Venue for interview will be at Conference Room, IIIrd floor, Plot No.147, Sector 44, Shri Vishwakarma Skill University, Gurugram.

The details concerning the eligibility conditions, area of specialization & other details are available on the University website www.svsu.ac.in.

Note:

- **Candidates do not meet the eligibility criteria and not having original documents in supports of their eligibility will not be allowed to appear in the interview.**
- **The university has a right to cancel or postpone the interviews any time.**

Eligibility:

- A.** (i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/ allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET.

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing ordinances/ Bye- laws/ regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such PhD candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/ SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/ Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions: -

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate had been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voice of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/ her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a referred journal;
- e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars, based on his/her Ph. D work.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

OR

- B.** The Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) ii) The Times Higher Education (THE) or iii) The Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Note:

1. NET/SLET/SET shall remain the minimum essential eligibility condition for recruitment and appointment of Skill Assistant Professors. However, those candidates who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Produce for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the minimum eligibility condition of NET/ SLET/ SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor.

Provided further, the award of degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil/ Ph.D programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/ By-laws/ Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and the Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/ Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions prescribed by the U.G.C. under point 3 of U.G.C notification dated 11-07-2016, published in the Gazette of India, New Delhi on 11-07-2016:-

- a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;
- b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners;
- c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
- d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal;
- e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/ seminars, based on his/her Ph. D work.

The above mentioned clauses (a) to (e) are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/Pro-Vice-Chancellor/Dean (Academic Affairs)/ Dean (University Instructions).”

2. A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and master’s level for the Scheduled Caste/ Differently Abled (physically and visually differently Abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the category mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
3. The period of time taken by candidates to acquire M.Phil. and/or Ph.D. Degree shall not be considered as teaching/research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions.

Instructions to the Candidates

1. The Candidate must be citizen of India.
2. Good knowledge of computer applications will be a distinct plus.
3. The required qualification and relevant experience etc. for eligibility shall be determined as on the date of walk in interview
4. Relaxation of 5% marks shall be awarded for SC/ST candidates.
5. All qualifications must be from recognized Board/Universities/Institutes. The Candidates who have obtained qualifications from any Board/University/Institution declared fake or not recognized by respective regulatory bodies shall not be eligible. Qualifications obtained through distance mode are not admissible for teaching posts in science and technology. If a Grade Point System is adopted the CGPA will be converted into equivalent marks.
6. The prescribed essential qualifications and experience indicated are bare minimum and mere possession of the same will not entitle any candidate for empanelment. The applications may be short-listed on the basis as deemed appropriate by the Competent Authority.
7. University reserves the right not to empanel the post advertised without assigning any reason.
8. All empanelled Faculty shall be paid remuneration as per UGC norms during their engagement with University.
9. The classes under dual education model will be conducted both at University Campus and Industrial premises as per requirement of the course.
10. No TA/DA is payable for attending the interview for the posts.
11. In case, the candidates fail to bring originals and attach self-attested copies of testimonials, their application would not be considered and they will not be interviewed.
12. Concealment of facts or supply of wrong information will result in cancellation of candidature at any time in addition to legal action.
13. The Candidates are advised to keep on visiting the website of the University for related updates including any corrigendum/addendum. Further, no information in respect of this advertisement shall be published in the newspaper.
14. A candidate found ineligible at any stage of selection/norms his/her candidature will summarily be cancelled.
15. Canvassing in any form will be treated as disqualification.
16. The Chairman selection committee shall have the power to lay down the procedure in respect of any matter not mentioned above.
17. Candidates should ensure that they fulfil all eligibility for the applied post as prescribed by the respective Regulatory body. The qualifications prescribed by Regulatory Bodies will be final and bonding on all.
18. All candidates are required to bring 1 set of photocopy of the original documents
19. The Schedule of interview will be published on the University website ONLY and no separate correspondence shall be made.
