SVSU Scholarship Scheme 2022-23

The Shri Vishwakarma Skill University, Palwal, Haryana awards the scholarship to meritorious candidates to attract high-quality students for enrolment in various skill programmes in the university. The semester-wise scholarship scheme is introduced for students in terms of concession in tuition fees for the different skill programmes. The details for award of scholarship for D. Voc / Diploma / B. Voc / UG programmes/ M Voc / PG programmes for a batch of 30 students is as under:

Mandatory Guidelines for the Award of Scholarship:

1. Scholarship will be awarded to the first eight meritorious students only, who will fulfill the desired criteria.
2. No scholarship will be awarded if the number of admitted students will be less than 1 / 3rd of the total intake in any programme.
3. In case there will be tie in the academic performance among students in the scholarship slab (from 2 Semesters onwards) students ' attendance will be the criteria to break the tie i.e. the student who will have higher % of attendance will get the scholarship.
4. Only those students who have passed the exam in the first attempt in every semester will be considered for the scholarship.
5. In case there will be tie among the scholarship slab for the newly admitted students of 1st Semester both the students will get the scholarship.
