2. Selection Criteria for Admission

The candidates will have to go through from the following stages of admission process to get the admission in Class XI:

2.1 Aptitude Test: It will be a Computer Based Test (CBT) for screening the students based on their previous grades level knowledge. There may be Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) based on the given syllabus & pattern with four options of answers and one correct among them.

2.2 Shortlisting of Candidates: Candidates will be shortlisted for skill test on the basis of merit of aptitude test score in the **ratio of 1:3**.

2.3 Skill Test: Shortlisted candidates will have to appear for a Skill Test to get final admission. It is the activity based / Viva-voce based psychometric assessment to assess the temperament, inclination and orientation of the candidates for the respective available skill subjects.

2.4 Final Selection for Admission: Final selection merit list will be based on the score of aptitude test and skill test.

2.5 Counselling: Reporting, Documents verification, Fees submission & Seat Allocation to the candidates.

Criteria for Merit Preparation for Final Admission

- i. 70 % Weightage to Aptitude test score (CBT / Entrance Exam)
- ii. 30% Weightage to Skill Test score
