RULES

General Code Rules:

1. To participate in Aravali Inter-College Annual Sports Meet 2K25, Institute must be registered (Annexure-A).
2. Participant should wear their sports kit.
3. Each member of the participating institute in Aravali Inter-College Annual Sports Meet 2K25 shall carry an Identity card and a **photograph attested by the Director/Principal of the concerned Institute (duly stamped and cross signed)** along with the college registration number & Aadhar card of the player.
4. No college team or individual players will be allowed to participate in Aravali Inter-College Annual Sports Meet 2K25, if they are not accompanied by their teacher in-charge.
5. Participating colleges will be provided accommodation on request. If made well in advance and confirmed by us. However, the accommodation cost will be borne by participating colleges.
 - Rs. 200/- person (breakfast & dinner provided)
6. If a participant is registered for multiple games and there is a time clash between events, it is the participant's responsibility to choose which game to attend. The college will not be responsible for managing time conflicts.
7. An authority letter is must from an institute; mentioning the total number of participants, faculty incharge name and contact number.

Note: Decision of the referee will be final and binding.

Each team event can have a maximum of 1 team from a college.

A participant can participate in maximum of 2 track and 1 field events (excluding of relay race).

Last date of Registration is 5 February, 2025.

Note: This is to notify that the participants must have to report at the respective venue at least 10 min prior to the start of event. In case He/She fails to report for any reason, He/She will be disqualified without any notice. To avoid this inconvenience kindly go through the schedule attached.

TRACK, FIELD & GAME EVENTS

All the events under these categories will follow the standard rules.

FUN EVENTS

Photography Contest

1. Participants are encouraged to capture the essence of the event creatively and responsibly. Photography should not disrupt or interfere with the ongoing activities.
2. Each participant can submit a maximum of 15 photos through the provided Google Forms.
3. Photos must be submitted within the specified time limit mentioned at the event.
4. Photos submitted must be original works taken during the event.
5. Participants are prohibited from submitting any offensive, or inappropriate content. Violation may result in strict actions, including disqualification.
6. Participants must fill out the Google Form accurately, providing necessary details such as name, contact information, and a brief description for each photo submitted.
7. All entries must be submitted within the designated time limit mentioned at the event. Late submissions will not be considered.
8. If the same photo is submitted by multiple participants, the photo submitted first will be considered for judging. Subsequent entries will not be taken into account.
9. The decision of the judges is final and binding. Judges will evaluate entries based on creativity, composition, and originality of the photos .
10. Participants are prohibited from using filters or watermarks on their submitted photos. Entries with filters or watermarks may be disqualified.
11. Participants retain ownership of their photos but grant permission for the event organizers to use and display the submitted photos for promotional purposes related to the event.
12. Participants are expected to abide by a code of conduct, respecting the privacy and rights of others. Any breach of event rules or disruptive behavior may lead to disqualification.
The best photos, as determined by the judges, will be awarded prizes.
13. Event organizers reserve the right to modify rules, disqualify entries, or take any necessary action to ensure the fair and smooth conduct of the photography contest.

Reel Making Contest

1. Participants must meet the eligibility criteria for the reel-making contest. Each participant or team can submit only one video entry.
2. Videos must focus on the sports fest events, covering a variety of activities and capturing the overall atmosphere. Participants are encouraged to showcase creativity and originality in their storytelling and presentation.
3. Videos should not exceed a specified duration, as mentioned at the event. Exceeding the time limit may lead to disqualification.
4. Participants must submit their video files via the provided Google Drive link at the event venue.
5. Participants retain ownership of their videos but grant permission for event organizers to use and display the videos for promotional purposes related to the sports fest.
6. Videos must adhere to ethical standards, avoiding any inappropriate content. Violation may result in strict actions, including disqualification.
7. Participants are encouraged to ensure a reasonable video quality for a better viewing experience. Low-resolution or excessively edited videos may impact judging.
8. Videos must be submitted within the specified timeframe mentioned at the event. Late submissions will not be considered for judging.
9. Videos will be evaluated based on creativity, storytelling, coverage of events, and overall impact. The decision of the judges is final and binding.
10. Participants must ensure that they have the right to use any music or copyrighted material in their videos. Any copyright infringement may result in disqualification.
11. Event organizers reserve the right to modify rules, disqualify entries, or take any necessary action to ensure the fair and smooth conduct of the reel-making contest.
