Opening Remarks:

At the outset of the meeting, the Registrar & Member Secretary of Skill Council welcomed the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Chairperson and other members of the Skill Council present in 14th meeting of the Skill Council for sparing their valuable time for attending the meeting. Thereafter, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor also welcomed the members of the Skill Council and presented the progress of the University in brief to the members of Skill Council as under: -

The Vice Chancellor apprised the Council that the University is offering 54 programmes including Engineering, Management and Applied Science etc. The University is reflecting steady academic expansion and alignment with industry and skill oriented education including the Skill Ph.D. programmes for Industry Professionals, which continues to attract working professionals and strengthen applied research and Industry engagement. The University has further enhanced its industry linkage through the establishment of a centre of Excellence with

Daikin, aimed at promoting advanced skill training, collaborative research, faculty upskilling and student exposure to contemporary industrial practices.

During the current cycle 41 institutes applied for affiliation with this University out of which 37 institutes have been granted affiliation after due inspection and compliance with prescribed norms, thereby, strengthening the University academic ecosystem and outreach.

In the Academic Year 2025-26, Concentrix Daksh Services India Private Limited has conveyed the Scholarships and it will continue for the selected students admitted during the session 2024-25 till completion of their respective courses. In addition to it, Knorr-Bremse India Ltd. and Mr. Mohit Oswal, Roop Industries have expressed their continued association with the University.

After that, the agenda items of the meeting were taken up as follows:

SC/14/01: TO CONFIRM THE MINUTES OF THE 13th MEETING OF THE SKILL COUNCIL HELD ON 05.08.2025.

The Skill Council confirmed the minutes of 13th meeting of the SC.

SC/14/02: TO REPORT THE ACTION TAKEN, WHEREVER REQUIRED, ON THE VARIOUS DECISIONS TAKEN BY THE SKILL COUNCIL IN ITS 13th MEETING.

The Skill Council noted the action taken wherever required and approved the same.

SC/14/03: TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE SUBMISSION OF 50% CONCESSION ON THE ACTUAL ACCRUED FINE OF RS 2,00,000/- (MAXIMUM) BY AFFILIATED INSTITUTE- RBS COLLEGE OF PHARMACY, BERLI KALAN (REWARI) FOR DELAYED REGISTRATION RETURNS OF PROGRAM BMLT FOR THE SESSION 2025-26.

The Skill Council considered the submission of 50% concession of actual accrued fine of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Maximum) on RBS College of Pharmacy, Berli Kalan (Rewari) for the session 2025-26 and recommended the same to the Executive Council for consideration and approval.

SC/14/04: TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE AMENDMENT IN ACADEMIC ORDINANCE REGARDING THE READMISSION FEE IN THE SAME SEMESTER IN THE NEXT ACADEMIC SESSION IN PROGRAMS.

The Skill Council considered the matter of amendment in Academic Ordinance regarding the re-admission fee in the same semester in the next academic session programs and recommended the same to the Executive Council for consideration and approval.

SC/14/05: TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE INITIATION OF PROCESS OF ESTABLISHMENT OF CENTRE FOR LEGAL STUDIES.

The Skill Council considered the initiation of process of Establishment of Centre for Legal Studies and recommended the same to the Executive Council for consideration and approval.

SC/14/06: TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE INITIATION OF PROCESS FOR COMMENCEMENT OF LL.M. PROGRAM IN FORTH COMING ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-27.

The Skill Council considered the proposed agenda for commencement of LL.M program from the Academic Session 2026-27 with the amendment that the grading system in the proposed documents may be aligned with the University grading system and recommended the same to the Executive Council for consideration and approval.

SC/14/07: TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE PHD PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSIONS, JANUARY, 2026.

The Skill Council considered the Ph.D. prospectus for the admission, January-2026 and recommended the same to the Executive Council for consideration and approval.

SC/14/08: TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE AMENDMENT IN ACADEMIC ORDINANCES, REFER TO ORDINANCE V GUIDELINES FOR CONDONING DEFICIENCY IN LECTURES/OJT, ETC. (UNDER SECTION 24 C OF THE SVSU ACT), CLAUSE- 1.

The Skill Council considered the proposed amendment in Academic Ordinance refer to Ordinance Guidelines for condoning the deficiency in lectures/OJT etc. and recommended the same to the Executive Council for consideration and approval being amendment in Ordinance.

SC/14/09: TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE AMENDMENT IN ACADEMIC ORDINANCES UNDER CLAUSE 9 OF THE ORDINANCE V GUIDELINES FOR CONDONING DEFICIENCY IN LECTURES/OJT, ETC. (UNDER SECTION 24 C OF THE SVSU ACT).

The Skill Council considered the proposed amendment in Academic Ordinance under Clause 9 of the Ordinance V Guidelines for condoning deficiency in Lectures/OJT etc. and recommended the same to the Executive Council for consideration and approval being amendment in Ordinance.

SC/14/10: TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE AMENDMENT UNDER CLAUSE 11.2 OF THE EXAMINATION ORDINANCE TO BE DELETED AND THE SAME TO BE INCLUDED IN THE ACADEMIC ORDINANCE AS NEW ORDINANCE GUIDELINES FOR DISTRIBUTION OF MARKS.

The Skill Council considered the proposed amendment under Clause 11.2 of the Examination Ordinance regarding deletion of old guidelines and to include the new amendment in Academic Ordinance for distribution of marks and recommended the same to the Executive Council for consideration and approval being amendment in Ordinance.

SC/14/11: TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE CREATION OF THREE FACULTIES:

The Skill Council considered the agenda for creating of the following three New Skill Faculties as under:-

- (a) Skill Faculty of Performing and Visual Arts (SFPVA)
(Departments to be run under this Faculty: Fine Art & Visual Art
Performing Art)
- (b) Skill Faculty of Medical & Allied Health Sciences (SFMAHS)
(Departments to be run under this Faculty: Pharmacy, Nursing, Physiotherapy &
MLT)
- (c) Skill Faculty of Interdisciplinary Studies

Further, recommended the same to the Executive Council for consideration and approval being addition in the University Statutes.

SC/14/12: ANY OTHER ITEM WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR

(A). TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE MEEETING OF CORE COMMITTEE FOR AAA AND FORMATS FOR INDIVIDUAL FACULTY AUDIT ALONG WITH ACADEMIC AND ADMINISTRATIVE AUDIT.

The Skill Council considered and approved the minutes of the meeting of Core Committee for AAA and formats for individual faculty Audit along with Academic and Administrative Audit.

(B). TO RATIFY THE ACTION TAKEN IN APPROVING THE AFFILIATION POLICY -2025-26.

The Skill Council ratified the action taken and recommended the affiliation policy of the University from the session 2025-26 to the Executive Council for ratification.

(C). TO RATIFY THE ACTION TAKEN REGARDING GRANT OF PROVISIONAL AFFILIATION TO THE NEW ACEDEMIC AND EXISTING OPERATIONAL INSTITUTIONS FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2025-26.

The Skill Council ratified the action taken regarding grant of provisional affiliation to the new academic and existing operational institutions for the Academic Session 2025-26 and recommended the same to the Executive Council for ratification.

(D). TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE RULES FOR MIGATION IN UNIVERSITY ACADEMIC ORDINANCE II- REGISTRATION OF STUDENTS (UNDER SECTION 24-C OF SVSU).

The Skill Council considered the proposed rules of migration for inclusion in University Academic Ordinance II- Registration of Students and recommended the same to the Executive Council for consideration and approval.

(E). TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE RULES REGARDING REFUND OF SECURITY MONEY OF STUDENTS IN ACADEMIC ORDINANCE.

The Skill Council considered the proposed Rules regarding refund of security money of students and recommended the same to the Executive Council for consideration and approval.

(F). TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE TO START NEW ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES UNDER THE DIFFERENT FACULTIES AND INCREASE SEATS IN TWO PROGRAMMES FROM THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2026-27.

The Skill Council considered the agenda for starting the following new programmes from the academic session 2026-27 under the different Faculties: -

(i) Skill Faculty of Engineering & Technology (SFET):

- a) B. Tech. in Mechanical Engineering for Working Professionals
- b) B. Tech. in Electronics Engineering (VLSI Design and Technology)
- c) Diploma in Civil Engineering
- d) Diploma in Electrical Engineering
- e) B. Voc. in Green Printing & Packing
- f) B. Voc. in Interior Designing in place of UG Diploma
- g) *M. Tech. in Computer Science & Engineering

**The proposal for starting M. Tech. Computer Science & Engineering programme is required recommendations of the Board of Studies of the respective department before placing the same in the meeting of Skill Council.*

(ii) Skill Faculty of Performing and Visual Arts (SFPVA):

- a) Bachelor of Performing Arts (Music)
- b) Bachelor of Performing Arts (Dance & Drama)
- c) B. Voc (Printing & Packaging)
- d) Bachelor of Fine Arts (Painting/Applied Art) Sculpture
- e) B.Sc. Animation & Multimedia
- f) B.Sc. Graphics Design
- g) Certificate in Jewellery Design (CAD)
- h) Certificate in Jewellery Retail Management
- i) E-Commerce & Digital Marketing for Jewellery

(iii) Skill Faculty of Medical and Allied Health Science (SFMAHS):

- a) Diploma in Pharmacy (D. Pharmacy)
- b) Bachelor in Pharmacy (B. Pharmacy)
- c) Bachelor in Physiotherapy
- d) B.Sc. Nursing

(iv) Skill Faculty of Agriculture:

- a) B.Sc. (Ag.)4 years with intake of 40. 15% seats will be filled up through CUET and remaining seats through Entrance Exam to be conducted by the University. Minimum 50% marks in 10+2 (PCM/PCB with Agriculture).
- b) Lateral entry for B. Voc Agri. students after first year and 10% seats will be reserved for them.

It was resolved that the Scheme, Syllabi and Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) of all the new proposed programmes will be placed in the forthcoming meeting of the Skill Council.

(v) **Increase of Seats:**

The Skill Council considered the proposal for increasing the seats in following two programs and approved the increase in seats from the session 2026-27 as under:-

- a) Bachelor of Technology in Mech. Engineering from 30 to 60 seats
- b) Bachelor in Electrical Engineering from 30 to 60 seats

(vi). In the end of the meeting, Ms. Sakshi, Student Nominee in the Skill Council suggested the following points for consideration: -

- (i) A lecture on Human Values may be arranged for the students
- (ii) Portrait of Maa Saraswati may be installed in the University Campus.
- (iii) A Flag may be got installed in the University Campus.

It was resolved that a lecture in every week may be arranged on Human Values for all the students of the University Campus. The Portrait of Maa Saraswati and a Flag of India be got installed in the Campus at appropriate places.

The Council recommended all the points of SC/14/12 to the Executive Council for consideration and approval/ratification.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
