2. Selection Criteria for Admission

The candidates will have to go through the following stages of the admission process to get admission in Class VI, IX, and XI:

2.1 Written Test - Descriptive written test to assess the previous grade-level knowledge of candidates.

2.2 Skill Test - Activity-based / viva-voce-based psychometric assessment to evaluate the

temperament, inclination, and orientation of candidates toward available skill domains.

2.3 Result Declaration – The result will be calculated based on 85% weightage from the written test and 15% weightage from the skill test.

2.4 Counselling - Reporting, document verification, fee submission, and seat allocation.
